We are promoting social distancing practices for final exams. That includes the use of additional classroom space to spread out our students, and utilizing additional personnel to serve as proctors.

As previously announced, the spring quarter has been modified to begin on April 4th; there will be no instruction during the week of March 30th. Due to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, courses will be delivered virtually to begin the spring quarter. Virtual instruction is anticipated to be temporary and will be assessed on a weekly basis in relation to changing conditions involving COVID-19. The spring quarter will not be extended. As of now, both campuses will remain open if students need a space to work or access to technology.

We continue to monitor the evolving COVID-19 situation, reviewing the latest information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
