M.A. Requirements (48 units)

The M.A. in Education Reading/Language Arts option program is organized to systematically link all courses with a unified set of research-based, classroom-applicable practices. All candidates must meet with their program advisor to develop their course plan. An approved program plan must be signed by the Program Coordinator and submitted to Student Services during the second quarter in the program.
