MPA Estimated Tuition Costs 2020 - 2021

Welcome

Students often ask about the total cost of the MPA degree or cost per unit. This is complicated by a variety of factors.

Costs for the MPA vary depending on:

- 1) California resident or non-resident status
- 2) Number of classes taken per term
- 3) Number of online classes taken

The MPA consists of 36 semester units - 3 units per class.

These are approximate costs:

California Resident Taking Only Traditional Courses (no online)

For one class a semester \$2,699 X 12 = \$32,395 or \$900 per unit

For two classes a semester \$2,699 X 6 = \$16,197 or \$450 per unit

For three classes a semester \$4,205 X 4 = \$16,822 or \$468 per unit

California Residents Taking online classes (\$540/per course)

For one class a semester \$3,239 X 12 = \$38,875 or \$1,080

For two classes a semester \$3,779 X 6 = \$22,677 or \$630

For three classes a semester \$5,825 X 4 = \$23,302 or \$648

Non-resident and International Students - There is an additional \$396/per unit fee in addition to the tuition prices above.

\$396 per unit X 36 units= \$14,258
