

# MSW PREREQUISITE WORKSHEET

## Fall 2020 Admission



All MSW students must have taken at least **one course** under each educational domain with a passing grade prior to starting the MSW program. Applicants can be conditionally admitted into the MSW program on the contingency that all prerequisites are met prior to the start of classes, Fall 2020. Refer to the *Prerequisite Course Summary* Form for further description of each required course.

**Applicants submitting an application to the MSW Program will need to verify in their application whether each prerequisite course has been met. Below is a checklist to assist in the tracking of whether or not these prerequisites have been met.** The courses listed under each domain are examples of course that may meet the prerequisite. Only 1 course must have been successfully completed to meet the prerequisite in each of the 3 categories below.

### CATEGORY A: Social Research Methods

Course within Social Sciences that would provide knowledge of **research methods**, logic, and data analysis.  
Example of approved courses: Social Work Research, Experimental Psychology, and Social Research

### CATEGORY B: Human Behavior

Course that would provide knowledge of the social and/or psychological determinates of human behavior.  
Example of approved courses: Human Behavior in The Social Environment, Socialization, Human Development, and Social Psychology

### CATEGORY C: Human Physiology

Course(s) that would provide student an understanding of basic human physiology.  
Example of approved courses: Biology, Biological Psychology, and Human Sexuality
