Student Teaching Track A or B Credential Requirements (48 units)

Students must attend an orientation session through the Teacher Education Office, when they will be assigned an education advisor and receive instructions to complete the Program Admission File (PAF). For program admission, students must successfully complete the pre-requisite courses and successfully complete or be currently enrolled in the pre/co-requisite courses. Candidates MUST pass all the CSET & CBEST exams prior to starting the program.
