**Subject:** CAMPUS NOTIFICATION: COVID-19

Cal State San Bernardino is committed to the health and safety of our students, faculty and staff. This notification confirms that a student member of the CSUSB community has tested positive for COVID-19. The student was informed of their positive test on May 23, 2020 and the campus was notified on May 25, 2020. The student attends and lives on the San Bernardino campus and has been self-isolating since being tested. The campus is regularly in contact with the student to confirm they are receiving care and support. While we understand this notification and the COVID-19 crisis are challenging, we ask that you respect the privacy of this student.

CSUSB was able to determine the on-campus locations the student visited while possibly contagious. Out of an abundance of care and caution, these locations have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected by trained personnel in Facilities Management and the Department of Housing and Residential Education. Risk Management has completed notifications to individuals who may have been in close contact with this student. CSUSB has been closely coordinating with the County Department of Public Health, as well as following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidance in responding to this case.

CSUSB has established protocols for reporting positive tests of COVID-19. If you have tested positive, or become aware of a member of the campus community who has tested positive, please follow the appropriate notification processes:

Acutely ill students should seek medical care from a healthcare provider in their area.
- **For COVID-19 Positive Employees** - Please email your supervisor and Risk Management (Beiwei Tu, Executive Director) at 909-537-4552 or [beiwei.tu@csusb.edu](mailto:beiwei.tu@csusb.edu). Employees should seek medical care through their regular health care providers.

The COVID-19 situation is dynamic, which means guidance from public health officials and the CDC changes frequently. We strongly advise that you comply with public health guidelines regarding social distancing, wear a face covering when outside your home, adhere to stay at home orders, and practice good personal hygiene.
