Subject: COVID-19 Regional Vaccine Update

The Departments of Public Health in both San Bernardino and Riverside Counties have authorized faculty and staff to begin making appointments to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. Interested employees must either live in or work in the county they are looking to receive an immunization.

Currently, there is limited supply of COVID-19 vaccine, as well as high demand. Faculty and staff should remain patient, as it will likely take weeks for available appointments to come available. Both counties are still prioritizing available vaccine doses to higher priority groups, such as those who are 65 and older, as well as front line workers in health care and emergency services.

When able to secure an appointment, CSUSB faculty and staff should be prepared to provide a driver's license or personal identification, a CSUSB faculty/staff identification card, and a recent pay stub, at the immunization appointment.

Students, including student assistants, are not currently prioritized for vaccination by the State of California, with the exception of nursing and social work students working in clinical settings, as well as student teachers who are currently engaged with in-person classroom instruction.

With the education tier now prioritized to receive the vaccine, CSUSB will continue pursuing potential opportunities to secure vaccination appointments with providers for our faculty and staff. Additional information will be released if and when these agreements are secured. Please do not contact campus offices for appointment information or vaccination access codes, as they are not currently available.
