Subject: Spring Term Mask and Booster Reminder

Campus Community:

The Repopulation Task Force continues to monitor the rates of COVID infection in our community and on our campus, and things are looking good! In San Bernardino and Riverside counties, the seven-day average number of new cases is 3.2/100k residents, and the seven-day test positivity rate in the two counties is 1.9%. On campus we have had two positive tests in the last 30 days of testing. We appreciate the efforts of every member of our campus community, which has slowed the spread of COVID-19.

The California Department of Public Health continues to encourage everyone who is eligible to obtain their COVID vaccination and to get boosted. Vaccination and booster appointments can be made at the on-campus testing center at <https://csusb.veritastesting.com>.

As a reminder, our current policy requires all members of the university community, regardless of vaccination status, to wear face coverings while indoors on campus unless:

- Working alone in a room or vehicle
- Actively eating or drinking
- Have received an accommodation from [Human Resources](#) (for faculty/staff) or [Services to Students with Disabilities](#) (for students)
