SUBJECT: Maximum Unit Load for Summer Semester Registration (Prior to Unit Overload Request)

ACTION REQUESTED

The Q2S Steering Committee requests that the Faculty Senate Executive Committee consider the Maximum Unit Load for Summer Semester Registration (Prior to Unit Overload Request) for undergraduate, graduate, and post-baccalaureate students be 14 semester units total, with the maximum in the 10-week session of up to 14 semester units and the maximum in the two 5-week sessions of up to 7 semester units each.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This unit maximum proposal is similar to local community colleges and sister CSU campuses.

The justification for the 14 units for undergraduate/post-baccalaureate students during Summer Semesters with the breakdown of up to 14 units for the 10-week session and up to 7 units for the 5-week sessions allows students to enroll in one lecture (typically 3 units) and one lecture/laboratory (typically 4 units) during the five week sessions.

The current procedure and approval process for course overloads will be carried over to semesters.
