Dear Colleagues,

As some of you may know, in the last two years we made changes in administrative oversight of international education, and the College of Extended Learning is now providing leadership and oversight for all international education. As a result of these changes, we saw the need for the name of the college to accurately reflect the scope of its activities. Similar changes have taken place on other CSU campuses when international education was moved under extended learning. After receiving feedback from the Faculty Senate Executive Committee, the following name has been approved effective immediately: **College of Extended and Global Education.**

The consolidation of all international education functions under one administrative umbrella has already brought some positive results and synergies. We have seen improvements in many processes, some examples of which are:

- shorter processing time of admission documents;
- access to one-stop-shop for all services for our international students and scholars;
- improved integration to campus life and transition into degree programs for English learners;
- increased access to international student advisors

We look forward to further improving services to our domestic students traveling abroad and international students coming to our campus, as well as to further advancing the internationalization on the campus.
