




First-time Freshmen Survey: Respondents Who Applied to Other Universities and Stated CSUSB Was Their "First Choice"




# FTF High School GPA




### **FTF with Transfer Units**







### **Time to Degree: By the Numbers**



# Our students don't want to graduate in 4-years. Most of them are working and/or want to take their time.


# Intent vs Action (Fall 2017)

2017 First-time Freshmen Survey "How many years do you expect it will take you to graduate from CSUSB?"




2018 First-time Freshmen Survey "How many years do you expect it will take you to graduate from CSUSB?"




### FTF 1st Term Mean Unit Load







### FTF 1st Year Academic Performance



### 1<sup>st</sup> Term Unit Load by HS GPA













