#### CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION TO CSUSB!

You are on your way to becoming a Coyote! Below are important steps to join The Pack at Cal State San Bernardino. You must meet the following deadlines to enroll at CSUSB this fall. Missing any of the required steps will result in the cancellation of your admission to CSUSB!

#### **Important Dates**

#### June 1 – Make Your Enrollment Confirmation Deposit to Accept Your Offer of Admission

All students must accept their offer of admission to be able to enroll at CSUSB. The only way to accept the offer of admission is by making the \$100 Enrollment Confirmation Deposit through your myCoyote account on or before June 1. The deposit is nonrefundable and non-transferable.

#### July 15 – Submit Final Official High School Transcripts

Turn in high school transcripts and any other documents by July 15. These documents must include all grades, the date of your graduation, and must be sent by your school directly to CSUSB via electronic file or traditional mail services. Remember, July 15 is the date the documents must be received by CSUSB – make sure your request to send the transcripts is placed with your school with enough time for processing!

#### July 15 – Register for Orientation or Coyote First Step

All students must register for their CSUSB transition program, Coyote First STEP or orientation by July 15. The program will include a mandatory advising session. Orientation is an opportunity to meet other new students, discuss academic choices with advisors, and explore majors and career options. Registration opens in early spring.

### Other Important Reminders

#### **Check your Coyote Email**

Admission requirements, deadline reminders, and updates about your admission status will be sent to your CSUSB email account. If you miss a deadline, your application will be canceled. Check your myCoyote and CSUSB email accounts regularly – at least once a week.

#### **Apply for On-campus Housing**

Living on campus is one of the most unique experiences you will experience as a college student. The Department of Housing and Residential Education can put you in touch with campus activities, faculty and so much more! If you are interested in living in one of our first-year student housing communities in Coyote or Serrano Village, please visit <u>csusb.edu/housing</u> for the online application.
