2022-2023 Outstanding Thesis/Project Award Call for Submissions!

CSUSB's Outstanding Thesis/Project Award formally recognizes those students who have shown exceptional scholarship and dedication in developing and writing their master's thesis or project. The two awardees will each receive a check for \$500 and a glass trophy to commemorate their achievement.

Categories:

- Humanities, Education, Business, & Social Sciences
- Math, Computer Science, Biological Sciences, Physical Sciences, and Life Sciences
- One student will be awarded in each category.

Requirements:

- Nominated and submitted by the graduate program
- One nominee per program
- Thesis or project completed during the 2022-2023 academic year

Nomination materials should be assembled in the following order and be submitted as one PDF file:

- A non-technical summary prepared by the student (1,000-1,500 words) describing the research and its significance for a general academic audience of non-specialists. Students should include their name and degree on the first page of the summary.
- Two nomination letters: One letter from either the department head or committee chair, and the other from a faculty member. The letter should include the following information: (1) The significance of the thesis/project, (2) The contribution of the thesis/project to the program, and (3) The impact of the thesis/project on the knowledge base of the discipline.
- A CV or resume from the student nominee.
- Email nominations to gradstud@csusb.edu by Monday, July 31.
