Students who are interested in the Biological Psychology Concentration or the Industrial and Organizational Psychology Concentration will need to take some courses at the San Bernardino Campus.

For the General Psychology Concentration, the Advanced Culminating Experience requirement is typically met by choosing a course from either the Advanced Experimental Psychology Option (PSYC 4431— Developmental, PSYC 4432— Clinical, PSYC 4433— Biological, PSYC 4434— Social, PSYC 4435— Personality, PSYC 4436— Learning and Motivation, PSYC 4437— Cognition and Perception, or PSYC 4438— Industrial and Organizational), or the Advanced Seminar in Psychology (PSYC 4421— Developmental, PSYC 4422— Clinical, PSYC 4423— Biological, PSYC 4424— Social, PSYC 4425— Personality, PSYC 4426— Learning and Motivation, PSYC 4427— Cognition and Perception, or PSYC 4428— Industrial and Organizational)</p> <p>For the Biological Psychology concentration, the Advanced Culminating Experience requirement is typically satisfied by taking either PSYC 4433—Experimental Psychology: Biological or PSYC 4436—Experimental Psychology: Learning and Motivation.</p> <p>For the Industrial-Organizational Psychology concentration, the Advanced Culminating Experience requirement is typically satisfied by taking either PSYC 4428—Advanced Seminar in IO Psychology or PSYC 4438--Experimental Psychology: Industrial and Organizational.</p> <p>At PDC, only three Advanced Seminars in Psychology (PSYC 4421, PSYC 4427, and PSYC 4428) will be offered alternatively. Other topics from the “Advanced Seminar” Option and any topics from the “Experimental Psychology” Option will only be offered at the San Bernardino Campus.</p>
