



SINGLE SUBJECT TEACHING CREDENTIAL

Student Teaching Track A or B Credential Requirements (48 units)

Internship Teaching Track Credential Requirements (56 units)

Admission to the university must precede admission to the credential program. The Student Teaching track is a three-quarter program that begins in Fall quarter for full-time students. Part-time students can complete the program in 2 years (5 quarters) and can enroll in the program in Fall or Winter quarter. The Internship Teaching track is an alternate program for those student-teachers who have been placed in an employed setting. This is a five-quarter program that begins in Fall or Winter quarter.

All candidates are encouraged to meet with their program advisor to develop their course plan. The following EXAMPLE course sequence is effective Fall 2013, and is subject to change at any time. Note: Internship Track Students must do an additional quarter of supervised teaching and an extra seminar of ESEC 556.
