Credential Requirements (48-52 units) M.S. Requirements (48 units)

All candidates are required to attend a New Student Orientation upon admission to the program to determine the appropriate track or course sequence to achieve their personal and professional objectives in Special Education. In the tables below, courses that ONLY apply to the credential program are *italicized* and courses that ONLY apply to the M.S. program are *bold*. The rest of the classes apply to BOTH programs. Prior to enrollment in the M.S. or credential program coursework, candidates must successfully complete the following pre-requisites: *HD 240 or equivalent Child Development (4 units)*; ESPE 530 (4 units); ESPE 531 (4 units); **EDUC 306 or equivalent Graduate Entrance Writing Requirement.**

All candidates are encouraged to meet with their program advisor to develop their course plan. The following EXAMPLE course sequence is effective Fall 2016, and is subject to change at any time.
