

# SACAGAWEA CRAFT

**Age Range:** Any

**Description:** Make a paper Sacagawea with simple materials!

**Time:** 30+ min

**Materials Needed:** Construction paper, scissors, glue, brown paper bag, pompom balls.

**STEP ONE:** CUT OUT A LARGE PAPER CIRCLE. THEN CUT OFF A STIP FROM THE TOP OF THE BAG AND CUT IN THE STRIP IN HALF. GLUE ALL THE PIECE ONTO THE FLAT PAPER BAG.



**STEP TWO:** CUT TWO PINK CIRCLE AND GLUE ONTO THE LARGE PAPER CIRCLE WHERE CHEEKS WOULD BE.



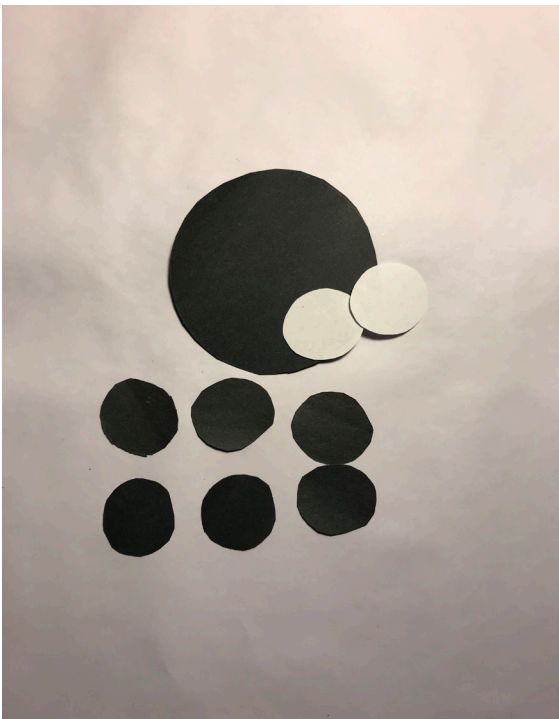

**STEP THREE:** DRAW AND CUT OUT A FEATHER SHAPE. FRAY THE SIDES OF THE FEATHER AND DRAW A LINE IN THE MIDDLE. THEN GLUE ON TOP OF THE LARGE CIRCLE



**STEP FOUR:** CUT OUT A LARGE BLACK CIRCLE, TWO SMALL WHITE CIRCLES, AND SIX SMALL BLACK CIRCLES



**STEP SIX:** GLUE THE TWO SMALL CIRCLES ON THE ENDS OF THE PAPER ARMS.



**STEP FOUR:** CUT THE LARGE BLACK CIRCLE INTO CRECENT SHAPES AND GLUE ON TOP OF THE HEAD.



**STEP FIVE:** GLUE THE SIX SMALL BLACK CIRCLES ON THE SIDES OF THE HEAD TO LOOK LIKE BRAIDS.



**STEP SIX:** FRAY THE BOTTOM OF THE BAG. THEN GLUE THE POMPOM BALLS THE THE BAG.





**STEP SEVEN: DRAW ON SACAGAWEA'S FACE AND YOU ARE FINISHED!**
