Ensuring the safety and well-being of you and our campus community is of greatest importance to us. CSUSB received notification of an individual who received a positive COVID-19 laboratory result and was recently on campus in a course that you may have attended.

Please self-monitor for up to 14 days after exposure and isolate if you begin experiencing COVID-19 like symptoms.

Unvaccinated individuals are required to follow the <u>CDC quidelines for COVID-19 quarantine</u>, for a 10-day quarantine. You should consult your personal physician or the Student Health Center for your healthcare needs if symptoms occur. Please do not visit the campus until **[ENTER Exposure date + 10 days]**.

If you are concerned and would like to be tested, you may <u>schedule a test</u> or walk-in for free on campus testing. This is available to all campus community members regardless of vaccination status. Vaccination appointments are also available. If you are quarantined, you are still permitted to come to campus for testing. Campus community members who test positive either at the on-campus facility or elsewhere needs to report the positive case using the <u>COVID-19</u> <u>Reporting Tool</u>.
