Brian Levin (Director, Center for the Study of Hate & Extremism) is a professor of criminal justice at California State University, San Bernardino, where he is the director of the Center for the Study of Hate & Extremism. He has testified before both houses of Congress and various state legislatures on hate and terrorism. He is also the principal or co-author of various United States Supreme Court *amici* briefs, journals, articles and books on extremism and hate crimes. Professor Levin formerly worked for civil rights groups and as a New York City Police Officer. He received his JD from Stanford Law School where he was awarded the Block Civil Liberties Award and his BA summa cum laude from the University of Pennsylvania with multiple honors in American History.

John Reitzel (Assistant Director of Research, Center for the Study of Hate & Extremism) is an assistant professor of criminal justice and assistant director of research for the Center for the Study of Hate & Extremism at California State University, San Bernardino (CSUSB). His research concerns the intersection of race/ethnicity and crime, perceptions of policing, and more recently, on the design and implementation of “Evidence Based Policing” to assess the effects of directed police patrols on micro-area crime rates. Dr. Reitzel regularly consults with police departments and not-for-profit prisoner reentry and rehabilitation programs. Recent partnerships include the Richmond (RPD) and Henrico County (HCPD) Police Departments in Virginia. Some of Dr. Reitzel’s publications appear in *Criminal Justice Policy Review*, *Controversies in Victimology*, *Police Quarterly*, and the *Journal of Criminal Justice*. He received his PhD in Criminology, Law & Society and MA in Sociology from the University of Florida in Gainesville, Florida.

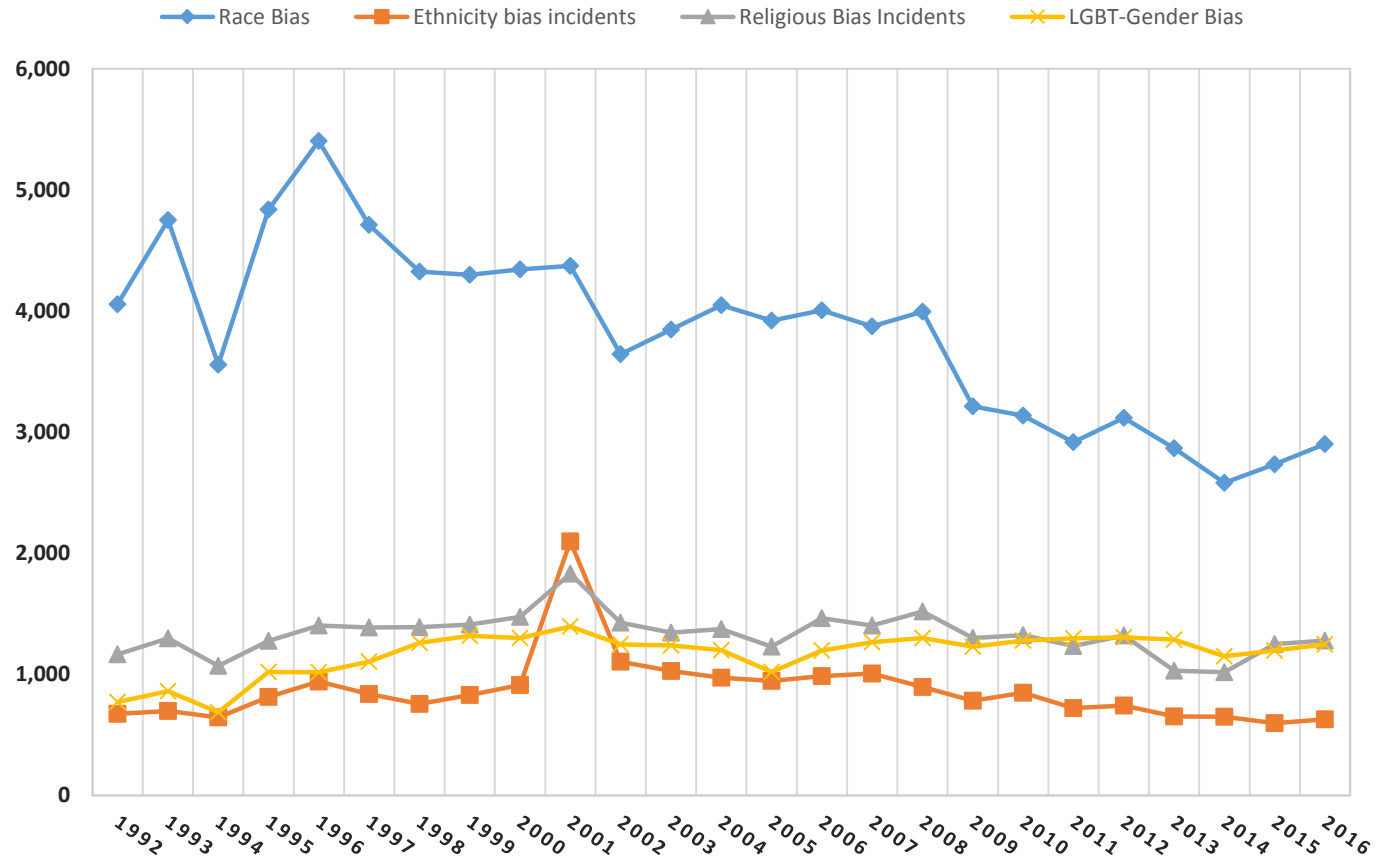
