

## String Area Audition Requirements

## **Bachelor of Arts**

- 1. Scales and arpeggios.
  - a. **Violin, Viola, Cello, Harp:** One major and one melodic minor scale, at least two octaves and preferably three. Must be performed memorized and with corresponding arpeggios.
  - b. **Double Bass:** One major and one melodic minor scale, at least one octave and preferably two. Must be performed memorized and with corresponding arpeggios.
  - c. **Guitar:** One major and one natural, melodic, and harmonic minor scale, two octaves. Must be performed memorized and with corresponding arpeggios.
- 2. One piece in any style.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. There will be one sight reading example.

## **Bachelor of Music**

- 1. Scales and arpeggios.
  - a. **Violin, Viola, Cello, Harp:** One major and one melodic minor scale, three octaves. Must be performed memorized and with corresponding arpeggios.
  - b. **Double Bass:** One major and one melodic minor scale, two octaves. Must be performed memorized and with corresponding arpeggios.
  - c. **Guitar:** One major and one natural, melodic, and harmonic minor scale, two octaves. Must be performed memorized and with corresponding arpeggios.
- 2. Two pieces in contrasting styles.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> This piece can be a "stand alone" work such as an etude, caprice, or lyrical/show piece, or can be a movement from a larger work, such as a sonata or concerto. If a student has an interest in alternative styles, the piece can be in a style such as jazz, bluegrass, mariachi, etc.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Must include one movement from solo Bach and one movement of a standard concerto, sonata, or substantial solo work.

3. There will be one sight reading example.
