6 Public Speaking Tips To Hook Any Audience

These are 6 ways you can hook your audience while speaking throughout the introduction, body, and conclusion of your speech.



Introduction

- 1. Use the first 10 seconds to grab your audience's attention.
 - Don't get right into what you're saying, capture attention first.
 - Dedicate the beginning of your speech to engage with your audience.
- 2. Get audience interaction.
 - Get them moving and responding to you because they'll engage more with what you're saying.
 - Asking a question that the audience responds to is a very effective way to get interaction.
- 3. Humor is a powerful tool.
 - It can engage audiences, make them more interested in what you're saying, and break tension.

Body

- 4. Humans are social creatures and we thrive on storytelling.
 - No matter how dry a topic is, telling stories in your speech will help your audience connect with you and keep them captivated.
- 5. When telling stories, even on dry topics, remember that you are performing.
 - Embody characters, use your body language to act out the scenes, use powerful and emotive language; the goal is to make your audience feel like they are right there, present in your story.

Conclusion

- 6. Leave your audience with a message.
 - Send your audience off with something they can carry with them, even after your speech ends.
