Temporary Medical Parking Permit

Please read these instructions carefully. Your signature will verify your receipt of the temporary medical parking permit and your understanding of its use. The permit must be accompanied by and displayed with a CSUSB daily, quarterly or annual parking permit.

1. HOW LONG CAN I USE THE PERMIT?

The permit is valid for two weeks and cannot be reissued. For parking longer than two weeks, a person must get a Department of Motor vehicles disabled person parking placard or plates.

2. WHO CAN USE THE PERMIT?

You are the only person authorized to display the decal. You are permitted to park in the disability parking stalls with blue signs. You may ride-share and display the permit, provided that you are one of the passengers.

3. WHEN IS THE PERMIT TO BE DISPLAYED?

The decal must be displayed any time you are parked in a disabled parking stall. Parking citations will be issued if the permit is not displayed. Please note that forgetting to display the permit will not void a citation.

4. SECURITY

Be sure to secure the permit at all times. Keep your vehicle locked. If you are unable to lock and secure you vehicle, contact Parking Services at 537-5912 for assistance.

5. UNEXPECTED PROBLEMS

If you have any unexpected problems about displaying this permit, contact the Parking Services before a parking citation is issued.
