This Timely Warning Bulletin is being issued in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act and the purpose is to provide preventative information to the campus community to aid members from becoming the victim of a similar crime.

Location: University Village Apartments, Bldg. 8, 1577 Northpark Blvd. San Bernardino, CA 92407

**Details:** On 01/12/2023, between 1725 and 1735 hours, a residential burglary occurred at the University Village Apartments, a residential housing facility of California State University San Bernardino. Investigation revealed an unknown suspect used an unknown tool to forcibly enter the north main doors of Building #8 at the University Village Apartments. While walking around the building, the suspect located an apartment door, which was propped open. The suspect entered the apartment without permission and stole a set of keys, which included the victim's house key, vehicle key, and dorm room key. The victim of the crime is a student of the University. The suspect fled from the scene prior to officers arriving.

#### Suspect(s) and/or Vehicle(s) Information:

Currently, the identity of the suspect is unknown. A review of surveillance footage revealed the suspect is a Hispanic male adult in his 40's, with a thin mustache and bald head. The suspect was wearing a black long sleeve shirt, black pants, and a gold chain necklace. The suspect got into an unknown silver 4-door sedan with a black sun roof.
