(TAs: 57 sessions* 3.25= 185.25 hrs; Teachers: 7 sessions, 3.5= 24.5 hrs). UCDD assessed the clients' adaptive behaviors with ABAS-3 to set the individualized goals. All goals established for the clients were approved by the funding agencies.
Provide weekly center-based counseling service for parents having children with developmental disabilities.	\$ 41,112	Provided 30 hours of center-based counseling sessions to 33 parents during this reporting period (Counselors: 10 sessions*3= 30 hrs).
