Welcome to the Watson and Associates Literacy Center.

The mission of the literacy center is to assist students, grades kindergarten through 12th, to improve in their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. The center provides assessment-based, intensive literacy remediation/tutoring sessions to the local community. Tutoring is provided by trained CSUSB students, supported by credentialed Reading Specialists, who provide one-on-one tutoring instruction. Funded by a generous grant from Watson and Associates, the center offers customized designed programs. Math homework support may also be available.

The cost of enrollment is \$90.00 for the first child and \$45.00 for each additional child in the family. The enrollment fee covers assessment materials and includes the CSUSB parking cost.

Tutoring sessions are Monday through Thursday, 3:30 PM – 4:30 PM or 4:30 PM – 5:30 PM.

The Watson and Associates Literacy Center (WALC) is closed on Fridays.

Attendance at each session is important for literacy progress, and the Literacy Center requests that enrolled participants attend each session. If illness or an emergence arises, place contact the Literacy Center before the start of your child's tutoring session. The contact number is (909) 537-2665. It is not always possible to make up a tutoring session, but contact the Director to see if a make-up session can be arranged on another day.
