LINKAGE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Completion of undergraduate coursework with a cumulative grade point average of at least **3.30** and a **3.30** or above in science coursework. Grades from all institutions attended must be included.

One year of general biology (BIO 2010 & BIO 2020)

One year of general physics (PHYS 2000, 200L & 2010, 2010L)

One year of general chemistry (CHEM 2100, 2100L & 2200, 220L)

One year of organic chemistry (CHEM 2400, 2400L & 2500, 2500L)

One year of English (ENG 1050A, 1060A)

One year of behavioral sciences (See Catalog)

One semester or equivalent in **biochemistry**, **physiology**, and **genetics** is **recommended**



WHERE TO APPLY

Students interested in applying for admission to the CSUSB-WesternU/COMP Linkage program will contact Health Professions Advising Center at CSUSB and provide the information required for the evaluation (page 2) as permitted by FERPA and documented with appropriate releases, to determine student eligibility.



APPLICATION DEADLINE

Submission of a completed AACOMAS primary application no later than January 31st of the year of specified matriculation at WesternU/COMP. Supportive letters of reference from HPAC, one additional science faculty member and one physician (DO or MD: DO preferred).



MCAT REQUIRMENTS

A total of 497 or better on the MCAT. The MCAT must be taken no later than January 31st of the year the candidate is specified to matriculate to WesternU/COMP.

WESTERNU/COMP EVALUATION REQUIREMENTS



CSUSB students have completed at least 60 semester units but no more than 90 semester units and are in the process of completing the required.

WesternU/COMP further requires that transcripts from all other institutions of higher education the candidate attended are provided at time of application to linkage.



Each Linkage program student is also responsible for sending grade reports each semester (copy of unofficial transcript) to the WesternU/COMP Admissions Linkage Committee by emailing to complinkage@westernu.edu.

The Committee will make final acceptance decisions after the WesternU/COMP Office of Admissions has received the student's MCAT scores. Upon receipt of acceptance, candidates have two weeks in which to notify the WesternU/COMP Office of Admissions of intent to enroll.
