

## 2021-22 CSUSB Economics Department Scholarships

### Information

The CSUSB Economics Department will award the following four scholarships for the 2021-2022 academic year: John and June Kennedy Economics Scholarship, Professor Tom Pierce Economics Scholarship, Economics Alumni Scholarship, and the Sean Brunske Economics Scholarship. The Kennedy and Pierce scholarships will be approximately \$3500 each; the Economics Alumni and Sean Brunske scholarships will be \$1500 each. The scholarship awards will be available for Fall 2021.

### Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for an Economics Department Scholarship a student must:

1. be pursuing a bachelor's degree at CSUSB as a declared economics major (any track) or political economy major;
2. have completed a minimum of 9 semester, or 12 quarter, units of economics course work with at least a 3.0 grade point average (2.75 for the Economics Alumni Scholarship and the Sean Brunske scholarship);
3. have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 (2.50 for the Sean Brunske scholarship);
4. have completed at least 30 semester, or 45 quarter, units of college course work;
5. be enrolled at CSUSB on at least a one-half time basis at time of receipt of the scholarship, i.e., fall semester, 2021.

Your application (the CSUSB Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships' "2021-2022 CSUSB Scholarship Application") will also require: (a) a letter of recommendation from a faculty member; and (b) a statement of purpose of 250 words (minimum) describing your educational/career plans for the first few years after graduation from CSUSB.

If you are applying for the Kennedy or Pierce Scholarships, your statement must also address financial need.

Note: most applicants apply for all four economics scholarships.

The **deadline** to complete and submit your '2021-2022 CSUSB Scholarship Application' is **March 2, 2021**.
