Incoming students may also take the Duolingo test online and select to send their scores to International Extension Programs (IEP) at CSU San Bernardino. The deadline to submit Duolingo English test scores is by Friday, August 21, 2020.

Additionally, students with TOEFL/IELTS scores may also submit these scores for placement in lieu of the Duolingo test by Friday, August 21, 2020.
