### **General Requirments:**

This document contains the application form for the NSF CyberCorps: Scholarship for Service program (<a href="http://www.sfs.opm.gov">http://www.sfs.opm.gov</a>) for students at California State University, San Bernardino.

# Minimum Eligibility Requirments:

- o Bachelors 3.0 GPA or better/Graduates 3.2 GPA or better
- o United States citizenship or premanent resident
- Ability to pass federal job clearance requirements, or security background check if required
- Full-time student or applicant within two years of graduation in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at CSUSB

# At CSUSB scholarship recipients shall:

- o Pursue an academic program in cybersecurity at CSUSB with no outside employment
- o Participate in two years of study and related activites in information assurance and security management and maintain a GPA of 3.0/3.2 or better depending on degree
- o Receive full tuition support as well as an allowance for related expenses such as textbooks, fees, professional certifications, and travel
- Maintain a lifestyle that is compatible with federal agency requirements to maintain a security clearance (i.e. no drugs, no felonies, good financial stewardship, U.S. citizenship)
- o Receive an annual stipend of \$22,500 for undergraduates and \$34,000 for graduates
- Participate in a summer internship in a government agency at the end of their first year of support
- o Upon graduation be required to work for a government agency for two years in fulfillment of their federal cyber service commitment (see SFS program details <a href="http://www.sfs.opm.gov">http://www.sfs.opm.gov</a> as commitment depends on length of support time)

- o Personal statement (see intructions on page 2) and resume
- Two letters of recommendation (professional and academic) and scholarship recommendation forms for both
- Formal admittance to CSUSB (new CSUSB applicants only; complete with transcripts from former institutions – unofficial accepted in interim)

## CSUSB CyberCorps: Scholarship for Service Personal Statement Instructions

In a separate document, with your name on each page, please write a personal statement (minimum one page, not to exceed three pages) that describes the following:

- o Any awards, academic recognition, honors, or distinctions that you have received
- o Any factors that uniquely or specially qualify you to receive this scholarship. Some areas to consider (but not required) are listed below:
  - 1. Knowledge of the techniques of the information security discipline, including encryption, access control, physical security, training, threat analysis, and authentication.
  - 2. Knowledge of the human factors in information security, including human computer interaction, design, training, sabotage, human error prevention, and identification, personal use policies, and monitoring.
  - 3. Ability to identify and analyze problems, distinguish between relevant and irrelevant information to make logical decisions, and provide solutions to individual and organizational problems.
  - 4. Ability to consider and respond appropriately to the needs, feelings, and capabilities of different people in different situations; be tactful, compassionate and sensitive, and treat others with respect.
  - 5. Ability to make clear and convincing oral presentations to individuals or groups; listen effectively and clarify information as needed; facilitate an open exchange of ideas and foster an atmosphere of open communication.
  - 6. Ability to express facts and ideas in writing in clear, convincing, and organized manners appropriate to the audience and occasion.
