## **PC 246 Shooting at Inhabited Dwelling**

### **CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SAN BERNARDINO POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**INCIDENT:** Shooting at Inhabited Dwelling

**LOCATION:** 5500 University Parkway, San Bernardino CA 92407 (Visual Arts Building)

**SUSPECTS:** Unknown

**VICTIM:** California State University, San Bernardino

*The investigation of last night's incident is being led by the San Bernardino Police Department and is ongoing. At 5:20 pm, reports of shots fired were called into the CSUSB Police Department. Witnesses identified the shots as coming from the vicinity of the Visual Arts Building and Parking Structure West. It was confirmed a bullet did enter a classroom window of the Visual Arts Building. The occupants of the classroom were uninjured and immediately moved out of the classroom to a secure area.*

*A shelter-in-place order was sent to the campus community as law enforcement officers searched for a suspect. Additional officers and resources from several allied law enforcement agencies responded and assisted. After an extensive search of the area, which was confirmed to be safe, officers cleared the buildings and evacuated occupants. A notification was sent to the CSUSB community that the shelter-in-place order was lifted and it was safe to leave the campus.*
