TIMELY WARNING NOTICE **ATTEMPTED ROBBERY (HANDGUN)**

Date: April 9, 2019 Time: 11:55 p.m.

Details:

On April 9, 2019, about 11:55 p.m., an Attempted Robbery of two CSUSB students was reported in Parking Lot C. The incident occurred when two unidentified suspects in a white sedan approached the victims as they walked away from their parked car in Parking Lot C. The driver of suspect vehicle initiated verbal contact, while the passenger exited the car and demanded the victims' property, brandishing a handgun. Both victims fled across Northpark to their nearby apartment. Neither of the victims were physically harmed by the suspects. The suspects fled the scene in their vehicle.

The crime was initially reported to San Bernardino Police Department (SBPD). When SBPD determined the crime occurred on campus, the case was referred to CSUSB UPD, who took over the investigation, interviewed the victims, and confirmed that any imminent danger to the CSUSB community had passed.

Suspect(s) and/or Vehicle(s) Information:

Suspect #1: (Front passenger) was described as White male adult, 21 to 26 years old, approximately 6 feet tall, medium build, short brown hair, with some possible facial hair, blue jeans and unknown color t-shirt.

Suspect #2: (Driver) was describe as White male adult with a "fat face", blonde hair, wearing a Dallas Cowboys baseball style hat with a silver star and wearing a grey hoodie.

Suspect Vehicle: White sedan.

Weapon Used: Black pistol

The CSUSB UPD is actively investigating this crime. CSUSB UPD will have an increased police presence in the area of the crime over the next few days. Anyone with information about this incident is encouraged to contact Detective Higgins at (909) 537-5165. Refer to CASE# 19-0197.
