After careful consideration and extensive discussion, the University's 2020 Spring Commencement ceremonies involving both the San Bernardino and Palm Desert campuses have been postponed due to restrictions involving the continuing COVID-19 outbreak.

We will continue to review all information and mandates received from the CSU, state and local officials.
