The Educational Opportunity Program (EOP), established through the state of California (SB 1072) in 1969, is designed to improve access, retention and graduation of historically low-income and educationally disadvantaged and underrepresented students who demonstrate the potential to succeed at the university level

- Please be aware that due to significant number of EOP applications received, you should apply early because the number of EOP admission placements is limited
- Students interested in attending CSUSB in 2026-2027 should file their Cal State Apply Application during the EOP Priority Application period from October 1, 2025 through December 15, 2025

Admission into EOP is not guaranteed; it is a selective and competitive process until admission capacity is reached.

When is the Deadline?

How do I Apply?

For the 2026-2027 EOP application period, the deadlines at CSUSB for both freshman and transfer applicants are as follows:

- December 15, 2025 (EOP Priority Consideration Filing Date)
- January 15, 2026 (EOP Application)
- January 31, 2026 (EOP Recommendation Forms)

Submission of EOP Application, EOP Recommendation forms and partial transcripts (with fall 2025 grades) must be received for a student's EOP Application to be reviewed and considered.

Financial Aid

The priority filing period for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is from October 1, 2025 through March 3, 2026. Check with your high school or community college counselor for further information regarding the FAFSA process. Students eligible for FAFSA must file online at studentaid.gov.

The California Dream Act Application (CADAA) is the financial aid application for AB-540 eligible students. It is the intent of application on the same day of the FAFSA. The application and instructions can be found at dream.csac.ca.gov.
