**For informational purposes only:** In accordance with California Assembly Bill 990 California State University, San Bernardino provides the typical market cost of a one bedroom apartment in the City of San Bernardino area.

The Room and Board expenses included in the off-campus Cost of Attendance represent the typical costs students pay when enrolled at CSU San Bernardino. Actual costs of room and board will vary. Many students living off-campus have roommates, which decreases their housing costs.

**Direct costs** are estimated costs that are paid directly to the university.

**Indirect Costs** will not appear on a student's account summary. These are *estimated* costs associated with going to college and are included in your cost of attendance. These out-of-pocket costs are taken into account when determining eligibility for financial aid.

\* Tuition/Fees based on 6.1+ units of enrollment plus \$420 per unit. Tuition/Fees for 6.0 or less units = \$2172 plus mandatory campus fees per term. Non-Resident Tuition applies to all non-residents of California including international (visa) students.

\*\* Loan processing fees are estimates and actual fees are based on amounts borrowed. Fees apply to cost of attendance for student loan borrowers only.
