## The Graduate Equity Fellowship

The Graduate Equity Fellowship seeks to increase the diversity of students completing master's degree programs at the CSU, encourages continuation toward doctoral programs, and promotes consideration of university faculty careers. It provides fellowships for economically disadvantaged CSU students who have had success in overcoming educational disadvantages and promotes faculty mentoring and research opportunities.

- Award amounts \$500 \$2,000
- California resident or have an AB540 affidavit on file
- Complete the FAFSA or CADAA
- Admitted to a master's program by the effective date of the award
- Apply through the CSUSB Scholarship portal for the next academic year. Opening date and submission deadline: pending

### **Grants and Loans**

#### **Grants**

- A grant is free money! This is money that does NOT have to be repaid
- Grants will be automatically accepted when added the students financial aid award
- < Example: State University Grant

#### Loans

- This is money borrowed and will need to be repaid!
- Loans must be accepted by the student.
- Additional steps are required by the student to have the loan be disbursed through the university.


#### State University Grant (SUG)

- The maximum annual SUG award is up to the tuition/fee
- Does not cover additional campus charges
- Limited funding and based on availability of funding at time of review
- May not receive a SUG if you are receiving another type of aid that pays your tuition fee costs.



### **FAFSA**

- Collects family's personal and financial information used to calculate financial strength of the household (SAI)
- For U.S. Citizens and eligible noncitizens, assesses eligibility for loans and federal and state grants
- Opened on 10/01/2025
- Using 2024 (for Fall 2026) Tax Year
   Income
- Priority Deadline is March 2nd.
- Available in English and Spanish



# California Dream Act Application (CADAA)

- Collects family's personal and financial information used to calculate financial strength of the household (SAI)
- For eligible undocumented students
- Opened on 10/01/2025
- Using 2024 (for fall 2026) Tax Year
   Income
- Priority Deadline is March 2nd.

## Tips for Completing Funding Applications

#### Be prepared to:

- Very continuous series of the continuous project of the continuous
- Reflect on how a commitment to diversity and underserved populations may be demonstrated in your written statement.
- Provide an overview of you plan to use the money and resources.
- < Respond to *all* the prompts.



## Megan's Writing Tips for Grants and Scholarships

- Develop a format based on the given prompt to organize your thoughts and ideas. Remember, you are telling a story through your Personal Statement, and a concise narrative for your reader to follow will be crucial.
- Be sure to make it your own, try to avoid cliché and boilerplate language. Use your own experiences to make the statement more personalized to you, this will help it stand out more!
- · Address all questions stated in the given prompt.
- Always proofread your statement before you submit it.
   Reading it aloud can help catch errors, as well as asking a 3rd party to review it.
- Take your time! Give yourself about a week to work on a Personal Statement, don't rush it.
