CAPTAIN RANDALL T. “RANDY” HOWE

Capt Randall T. Howe is the Operations Flight Commander and an Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies at the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC), Detachment 002, California State University, San Bernardino. In this capacity, he is directly responsible for the training, education, and development of officer candidates into Air Force commissioned officers through a comprehensive college program.

Captain Howe entered the Air Force in June of 2018, after five years in the AFROTC program at Loyola Marymount University, while studying Civil Engineering at California State University, Long Beach. Prior to his current assignment, Captain Howe was the Deputy, Installation Management Flight for the 374th Civil Engineer Squadron at Yokota Air Base, Japan. He led a flight of 143 personnel, guiding record keeping and reporting for 828 facilities across 14 geographically separated units valued at \$14.5B. His flight provided housing for 11.5K personnel across 58 mission partners, managed the wing's 12 environmental compliance programs, and oversaw the execution of \$178M US and Japanese funds. Captain Howe has experience in a wide variety of base-level roles at four overseas Civil Engineer Squadrons, including Royal Air Force (RAF) Lakenheath, United Kingdom (UK), Osan Air Base (AB), Republic of Korea (ROK), and a deployment to Anderson Air Force Base (AFB), Guam.
