**BASW:** The Bachelor of Arts in Social Work (BASW) is an entry-level degree in the profession of Social Work. ### **Bachelor of Social Work (BASW) Degree Program**

New students are admitted each Fall. Interested applicants must apply and be accepted to both the University and the School of Social Work for consideration. Current students and transfer students should plan to complete their social work application in the Fall Semester of their Sophomore year.

# Master of Social Work (MSW) Degree Program

The MSW Advanced Standing Program admits new students in the Summer. All other MSW degree options admit each Fall term.

#### **Practicum Education**

Practicum education courses run concurrently with the Bachelor's of Social Work (BASW) Degree Program and the Master's (MSW) Degree Program. Practicum Education includes practicum placement, seminar, and professional events that are designed to create a learning experience that allows students to apply theory and demonstrate skills learned in the classroom.
