In accordance with the Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990, California State University San Bernardino is pleased to share with you the following information on the graduation rates of our Fall 2019 cohort of full-time, first-time, degree or certificate seeking undergraduates.

As reported in the IPEDS graduation rates survey (GRS), during the Fall 2019 semester, 2,846 first-time, full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students entered California State University San Bernardino. Of these students, 53% had graduated from California State University San Bernardino within 150% of the normal time to complete their degree (as of August 31, 2025). - All graduation rates are based on up to six years of attendance for bachelor’s programs, which equates to 150% of the normal completion time.
- We have elected not to report transfer-out rates because our college’s mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in another eligible institution without completing or graduating.

- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
