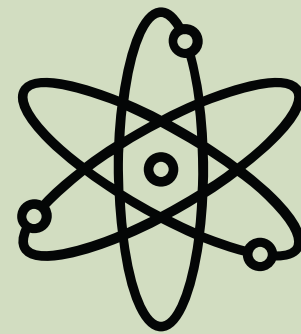

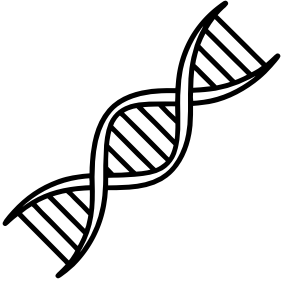
****Attending Interest Pack Events**
