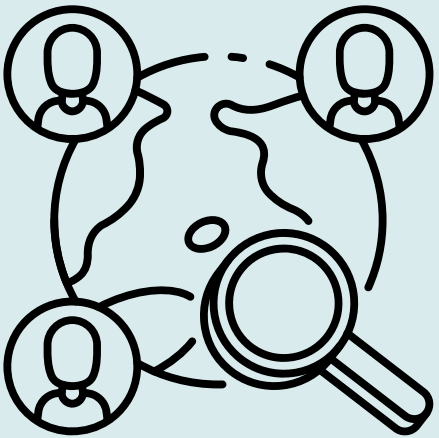

Four-Year Freshman Student Engagement Roadmap



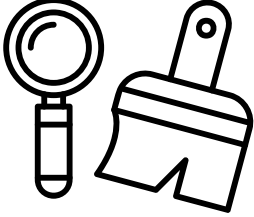
