Cal State San Bernardino accepting undergraduate applications for Spring 2027 admission

PALM DESERT, Calif. – Cal State San Bernardino, including its Palm Desert Campus, is accepting undergraduate applications for the Spring 2027 term. First-time freshmen, as well as lower-division and upper-division transfer students, are encouraged to apply by the Sept. 30 deadline.

For students who have missed the fall application window, this spring admission cycle offers another opportunity to begin their academic journey at CSUSB this year. Spring classes start in January, and space is limited — early application is strongly encouraged.
