Some jobs **require** a master's degree or doctorate.



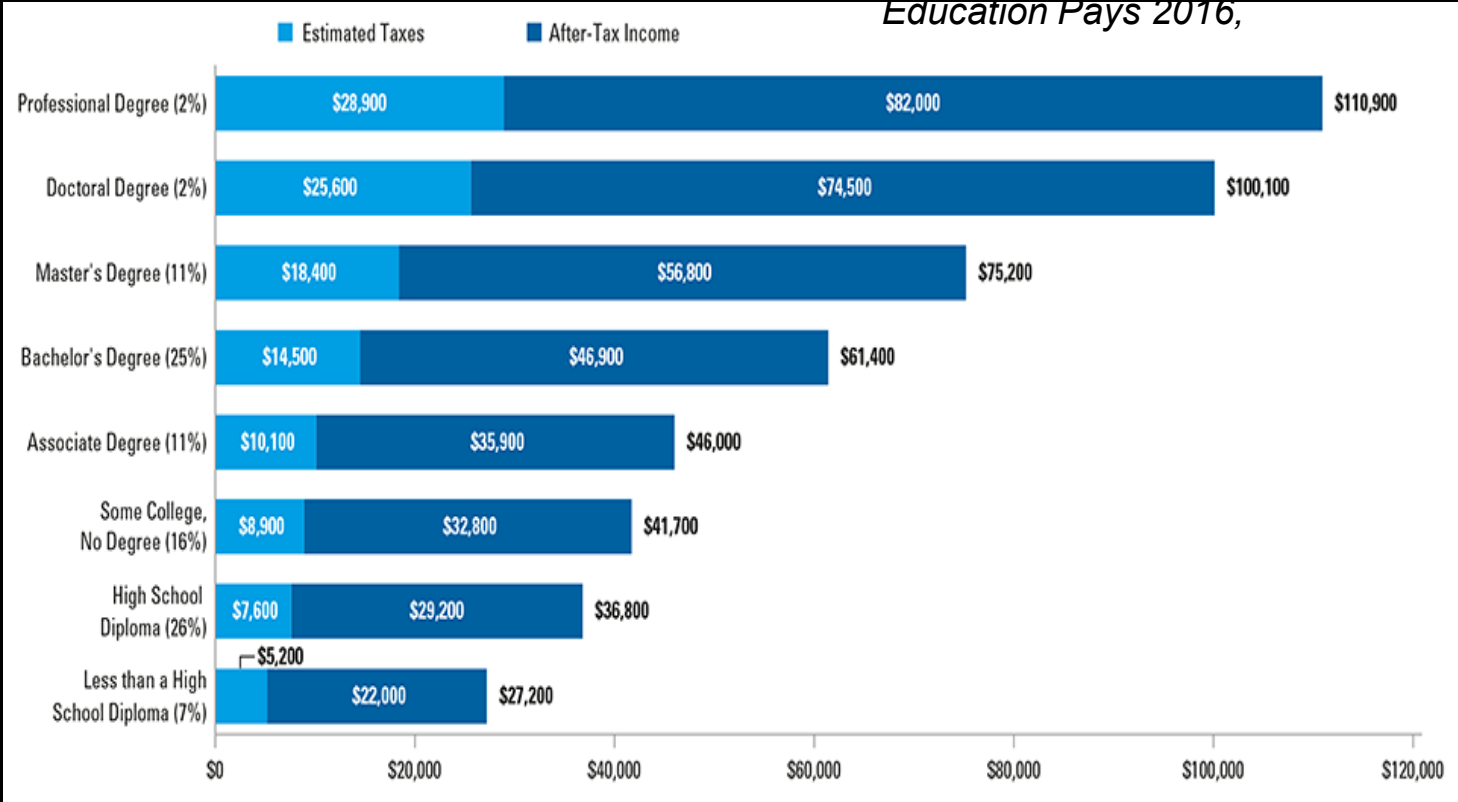
Those with a graduate degree **earn more** in almost all jobs.
