

BS NTFS 3 year plan for transfer students, who completed lower division GE but did not complete CHEM and BIOL courses May add a minor or certificate program, e.g. certificate in Gerontology certificate in Spanish for Health Profession, certificate in Health Disparity

NTFS classes are only offered once a year and you must have an overall GPA > 2.8 and >B- for 300 and 400 level courses to receive the Verification Statement required for application to dietetic internship programs

Students may graduate with BS in NTFS with a grade >C in courses higher than 300 and maintain an overall GPA of >2.0 without the Verification Statement from Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD)
