





 - Einstein Bros. Bagels & new Coyote Market (September)







Dining Projects at SMSU Summer of 2018



Blue Coyote Pub

- We've held a number of meetings with SMSU administration on improving the Pub experience:
 - □ Added two new 65" TVs
 - Working to install high definition digital TV service
 - □ Going to add second electronic menu board
 - Adding new electric sign on 2nd floor entrance door wall
 - Working with Coyote Dining on improved menu with more daily specials
 - Redesign of the space to enhance the pub experience including new wall wrap and vintage decorations
- PepsiCo will feature their new Stubborn Soda soft drink line featuring all natural ingredients





Pizza Hut Express

- Part of our enhancement efforts included looking at the Pizza Hut unit. Just as we were about to begin investigating other brands Pizza Hut approached us with a proposal to refresh their product line.
- The refresh includes improved aesthetics of the space with signage, tile, and a new counter, including a "build your own" option.
 - New pizza recipe with fresh and natural ingredients
 - Increased value due to a larger 9 inch size personal pizza versus current 6 inch size
- A taste test of the new pizza was held on January 18th with representatives from SMSU, ASI and the Campus Dining Advisory Committee providing positive feedback.

Starbucks Conversion

- Current Starbucks space will close once the new Starbucks opens at the Pfau Library. (Late June)
- UEC is planning to convert the space into a new student driven concept.
- We gathered input from the Campus Dining Advisory Committee and worked with ASI to send out a student survey asking what beverage products would you like to see in this new concept:
 - 1400 respondents
 - Top Five Requested Products: Smoothies, Boba tea, Coffee, Hot or Iced Teas and Milkshakes
- Working with Office of Strategic Communication and Sodexo Corporate Marketing on a new "hip and trendy" name that compliments the core menu.








Coyote Market Refresh
