Helpful Hints:

Take a picture of your bicycle to provide an exact description in the event it is stolen.

To prevent the loss of accessories such as lights and bags, etc., they should be detached and taken with you when the bicycle is left unattended.

Bicycle Safety

- · Always wear an approved bicycle helmet.
- · Walk your bicycle across streets.
- · Always keep to the right side.
- · Maintain your bicycle in good condition.
- · Never ride between two cars.
- Obey all tragic signs and signals.
- · Wear bright or reflective clothing.

BICYCLE THEFT

Bicycle theft is an ongoing problem in the community. Many bicycles are left unattended and/ or not locked. Many do not have serial numbers, which makes the identification and recovery of lost or stolen bicycles difficult. The Cal State San Bernardino University Police Bicycle Registration Program is one step you can take to help improve your chances of having your stolen or lost bicycle identified and returned to you. The mission of this program is to reduce bicycle theft and assist the public in the recovery of lost or stolen bicycles. This program is offered to students, faculty and staff and is free of charge.

WHY IS A SERIAL NUMBER IMPORTANT?

Serial numbers are a set of characters that uniquely identify an object and can be used for traceability or warranty purposes. Serial numbers are especially important when reporting stolen items, such as bicycles. A serial number can be used to enter a bicycle into a nationwide database as stolen. Input into these databases increases your chances of having your bicycle recovered, and makes it possible to file criminal charges against the person in possession of the bicycle.

AN OUNCE OF PREVENTION... HERE IS WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- Register your bicycle with the CSUSB University Police Bicycle Registration Program.
- Park and lock your bicycle in a well-lit area.
- Choose a lock that leaves as little space as possible between the lock and bicycle.
- Use a good quality lock such as a hardened steel lock and padlock or a 'U' shaped lock.
- Lock your bicycle and both wheels to a secure immovable object.

Remember to keep a copy of your sales receipt. If your bicycle is stolen, report it immediately to your local police department.

If you sell your bicycle or change your address or telephone number, please update your information with the CSUSB University Police Department.

Upon approval of your registration form you will receive a registration sticker. The tracking number is exclusive to you and indicates your bicycle is registered with the University Police Department. Apply the sticker to your bicycle where it can be seen as a visual deterrent to theft.
