Jaworski confirmed that each of the ATI subcommittees have been successfully meeting regularly. Jaworski also updated that ATI coordinator candidates will be on campus during the month of June, with an official hire to take place in early summer. It was requested to have the successful candidate join the CAAB committee and quarterly meetings.

Robles stated the gate arm installation construction will begin the week after commencement. FPDC will start meeting with the appropriate personnel prior to the installation. Robles reported that the campus accessibility guide will be sent to CAAB for review prior to being finalized. Departments have already provided updates to their respective areas.

Au commented that Drupal does not have a compliance feature, but the campus continues to use the Compliance Sheriff software to capture and correct any compliance issues on the University's webpages.

Au highlighted that 90% of the new compliant paths of travel campus phones have been installed. The remaining 10% will be completed prior to the start of Fall classes.

FPDC and Facilities Management will be meeting to share ideas on how best to communicate campus disruptions when it comes to construction and access paths.
