Transportation for PDC Students at UCR Building

Sorenson stated that Palm Desert Campus students and faculty use classrooms at the UCR building but are not allowed to park in that area. Currently, there are no accessible paths of travel to walk between the UCR and PDC campus buildings. Freer inquired about the possibility of reciprocal parking allowances for the UCR and PDC lots.
