1. Announcements

a. <u>Dr. Rueyling Chuang, Associate Dean</u>

- o **Equipment Requests:** Dr. Chuang received all requests and will forward approvals by Thursday, February 22 (if additional meeting is required, notification will follow).
- o **Course Match (CM):** Dr. Chuang followed up on CM submissions for the spring quarter. A total of six courses were approved.

a. Dean Terry Ballman:

- Women's Leadership Conference: Dean Ballman mentioned the Women's Leadership Conference which was held on February 2.
- Diversity Conference: Dean Ballman spoke about Dr. William Harvey's visit. Chairs made positive comments about the luncheon they had attended. Dean shared that she attended the Dean's Special Session and closing session.
- o **Reassigned Time Taskforce (RAT):** Dean Ballman shared with Chairs that the RAT taskforce met again on February 2 and discussed budgets in relation to reassigned time.
- Winter Faculty Colloquium: Dean Ballman mentioned the success of the faculty colloquium on February 13 which focused on gender. Presenters included: Mo Bahk (COMM), Sara DeMoss (CAL), and Julie Taylor (COMM).
- Native Voices Poetry Festival: Dean Ballman shared that she attended the Native Voices
 Poetry Festival on February 10 at the Dorothy Ramon Learning Center in Banning, CA.
 Presentations included poetry with music and video image. Dr. Carlson also attended and made
 an interesting presentation.

2. Budget – M. Fuller:

- o **Summer 2017 Incentive Funding**: Michelle presented the summer incentive distribution for departments. Funds can be used on any general operating expense.
- CERF Internal Audit: Michelle stated that the College of Extended Learning audited all
 university CERF fund transactions. Michelle shared findings of the auditing report and reminded
 Chairs that documentation is key to correlate spending to self-support programs, and Open
 University.
- Winter 2018 SFR: Michelle shared the Winter SRF report with Chairs (spreadsheet will be sent to Chairs via email).

3. 60-Second Elevator Speeches – CSUSB "We Define the Future"

a. Time-To-Degree:

Dean Ballman shared that it is our obligation to prepare students for the workplace and careers, in addition to graduate school.
