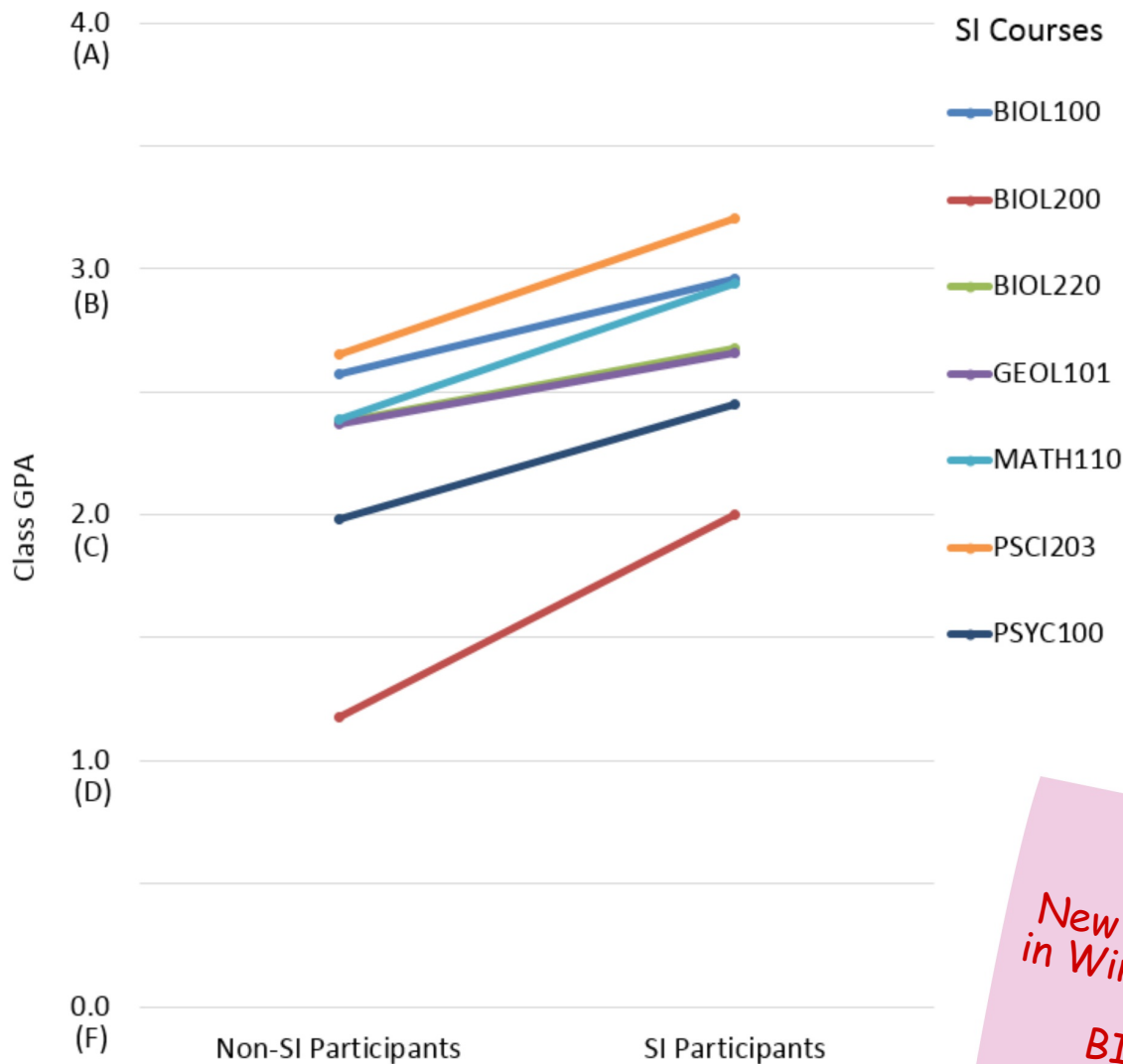


Did You Know

Students who attended supplemental instruction (SI) received higher grades?

Matched Sample* Comparison



*What is matched sample?

Matched sample enables group comparisons by reducing the effect of bias.

It does so by matching each individual in the treatment group (SI) with an individual in the comparison group (non-SI) on specified variables.

The variables used for this comparison are listed below the figure.

Note: PSYC210 is not shown above due to limited sample size (n=4). SI and non-SI students were matched on course, gender, ethnicity, student level, Pell grant status, cumulative GPA, high school/transfer GPA, full/part-time status and course repeat status. Data based on students in supplemental instruction courses in Fall 2016 (N=4,774) and Matched SI Sample (N=410).
