Subject: San Bernardino Campus Master Plan - Town Hall #1 - June 4

A Special Message to the CSUSB Community,

On Thursday, June 4, from 10:00-Noon, and repeated again from 4:30-6:30pm, the first town hall meeting will be hosted by Facilities Planning and Management as we begin development of the next Campus Master Plan for the San Bernardino campus. Town Hall #1 will be held in San Manuel Student Union, Events Center. The two sessions on June 4 are identical and there is no need to attend both.

Building off of the guiding principles and goals of the new CSUSB Strategic Plan, the Campus Master Plan will create a physical roadmap for the future of the San Bernardino campus. It will address the current utilization of academic and service departments, future expansion of facilities to accommodate enrollment growth; parking and circulation; student housing; student life functions; landscape; playfields and athletics; safety, lighting and security; and strategies to create a more sustainable campus.

To be successful, the consultant team and University leadership need your input. Town Hall #1 will introduce the consulting team who will be working with CSUSB through the end of 2016. In addition, discussions will focus on the purpose of a campus master plan, a review of current campus physical conditions, goal setting for the plan, and participants will be asked to share their insights on important issues that should be addressed in the next master plan.

To further facilitate broad participation, the University will develop a website dedicated to the Campus Master Plan, which will be updated as the process continues and those who are unable to attend meetings can stay informed and provide input through virtual channels. All planning materials used in the campus Town Halls will be posted on the website and the website will provide a readily accessible avenue for input.

A separate Campus Master Plan for the Palm Desert Campus will begin development in Fall 2015.
